

NAVIGATING THE SITE and FORUM

ACTION IN THE MAIN FRAME

Everything on the HELADA website, including the Forum, opens in the Main frame. Even article links in a Forum post will open there.

Most of the Issues and other static pages have 'back' links, e.g. **Back to the Home Page**. The main Back (and Forward) arrows on your browser ① will also change the pages in the Main frame in the order you've visited them. Try it!

The Banner and Contents frames always show, and can be used to navigate among the main sections of the website.

- Use any of the buttons on the horizontal button bar under the banner ②
- Or go directly to an Issue category by clicking a link in the list in the Contents frame.

USE A NEW TAB IF POSSIBLE

It's a good idea to open the HELADA website on a new Tab. It's not necessary, but it makes navigating easier at first. See the Tab Bar ③ in your browser, like the one below. In some browsers, you can click (double? right?) on an empty space in the Tab Bar to open a new Tab.

SITE MAP

Note that we also have a sort of 'site map' ④ just under the greeting on the home page. These four lines tell site visitors what they'll find in the main sections of the static part.
